The Abbotsford Youth Commission is offering a program for grade 7 students called **Just For Girls** and **Guys Alive**. This program will be offered at your child's school one lunch hour per week for approximately 8 weeks.

The aim of these programs is to provide an opportunity for youth to talk about issues that may influence their self-confidence and to help them develop strategies to combat negative experiences resulting from peer pressure and conflicts with friends. Interactive games are played to encourage a positive feeling of self worth, while role plays and experiential exercises are used to identify ways to cope with issues and negative experiences. Feelings and experiences are validated through games, art and discussions which help youth work through issues and develop a positive sense of themselves and their abilities. **Topics covered may include:** 

- Peer Pressure and Conflicts with Friends
- Bullying
- Online Safety
- Role Models
- Healthy Lifestyles and Body Image
- Friendships
